Carliss' dissertation was titled, "Interpersonal Competitive Dynamics in the Workplace: The Dark Side of Demographic Similarity". Carliss accepted a faculty position at Sam Houston State University as Assistant Professor of Management, where she teaches Human Resource Management, Organizational Behavior, and Leadership in Teams. Currently, Carliss is the one of only 196 female, African-American, management business school professors in the U.S., and she looks forward to increasing the number of minority business professors.
